# WOMAN GIVES BIRTH TO CALCIFIED BABY

This week one Cleveland Woman by the name of Cathy Brambleton gave birth to a calcified baby after 18 years of it's due birth. The doctors gave her the option to remove the baby after sadly dying before birth, but she refused because she couldn't bear to see the sight. We do not know which one is worse! (Pictured on the right.) This heavy stone was carried by the woman for over 17 years, making the baby an adult. Here is some additional information on Lithopedion. It is a rare phenomenon which occurs most commonly when a fetus dies during an abdominal pregnancy, is too large to be reabsorbed by the body, and calcifies on the outside as part of a foreign body reaction, shielding the mother's body from the dead tissue of the fetus and preventing infection. Lithopedion may occur from 14 weeks gestation to full term. It is not unusual for a stone baby to remain undiagnosed for decades and to be found well after natural menopause; diagnosis often happens when the patient is examined for other conditions that require being subjected to an X-ray study. A review of 128 cases by T.S.P. Tien found that the mean age of women with lithopedion was 55 years at the time of diagnosis, with the oldest being 100 years old. The lithopedion was carried for an average of 22 years, and in several cases, the women became pregnant a second time and gave birth to children without incident. Nine of the reviewed cases had carried lithopedion for over 50 years before diagnosis.



# 5 EASY AND EFFECTIVE METHODS TO WARDING YELLOW-BELLIED GREASEMONGERS FROM YOUR GARDEN

The yellow-bellied greasemonger (*Flavopestis humidum*) can be a serious pest to gardens in the rural parts of Ohio. Their habit of destroying plants by chewing stems and eating at roots makes them a nuisance for many farmers and gardeners across the state. Their problematic nature is increased even more due to their resistance to pesticides and fast reproduction rate, which can make them extremely challenging to exterminate. Luckily, we found 5 effective and simple techniques to get rid of these slimy menaces.



## 1. Rock salt

Spreading rock salt across your lawn is one of the most efficient ways to keep yellow-bellied greasemongers away from your plants. Greasemongers have extremely sensitive skin, and contact with salt can give them a painful shock, which makes them avoid invading your garden.


